2. Was there a question texted in this past weekend's service that resonated with you? How did it impact your thinking?
3. Is there a question or topic that makes you uncomfortable to discuss? Why do you think that is?
4. How can our group support each other when facing tough questions or doubts?
5. How can seeking answers to hard questions strengthen our relationship with God and others?
6. Who in your life could benefit from an open conversation about questions they have?

Gather as a group for a time of prayer. Take turns going around the room, lifting each other up and bringing your collective needs before God.
