GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. What is an area you need prayer right now? Spend time praying out loud as a group after everyone in the group has time to share.
- 2. Have you ever prayed and didn't receive an answer right away? How did you feel during the waiting period? What does waiting on God do for us and develop within us?
- 3. How easy is it to put God on your timetable instead of His? What opportunities for growth do we miss by doing this?
- 4. Have you ever experienced a miracle or a major change through prayer? If so, please share.
- 5. Read James 5:16 Discuss this verse with your group. Why do you think there is power in confessing to one another and praying together? Do you think there is a connection between James 5:16 and Matthew 18:18-20?
- 6. What does it look like to trust God regardless of the answer to your prayers?

Go around your group and ask for prayer requests. As a group, spend time praying over each other. Check your HEART. Are you Hurting, Exhausted, Angry, Resentful, or Bitter? Pray for the Holy Spirit to reveal any of these areas and ask for help to take the necessary steps to find healing.
