 - How do you think you would have reacted if that was you?
- 3. Jesus is 100% Grace and 100% Truth. While Jesus is full of both Grace and Truth, most of us have one or the other that comes more naturally to us.
 - o Is it easier for you to show grace or easier for you to share truth? Why?
 - It's not loving to show grace without truth, and truth without grace is like a clanging gong. Share a time when you showed grace without sharing truth, or a time when you told the truth without giving grace.
 - How does knowing that Jesus is 100/100 change your perspective on how to respond to others?
- 4. What is one area in your life where you can give more Grace?
