Other Potential Questions:

Q. Can I choose to attend at any host campus, even if my home campus is hosted somewhere else?

A. Yes, you may choose to attend camp at any host campus, even if your home campus is attending elsewhere. Campuses are assigned a host to help ensure your child is grouped with staff, leaders and other kids they know. We encourage you to attend with your home campus for the sake of building lasting friendships, but if one of the other campuses works better for your family you are welcome to register wherever you'd like.

**Note For Casa Grande Families: We will only be providing transportation from Casa Grande to the South Gilbert Campus. If you register somewhere else you will be responsible for transportation to and from the host campuses.

Q. Who are we partnering with for the offering and service projects?

A. This year we will be partnering with Midwest Food Bank. We will be collecting money and canned goods to be donated to Midwest- you may bring your offering any day of camp! In addition, kids will be packing hygiene packages for kids in need in our community through the Starbright Foundation. We're excited for your kids to help make a difference in their communities!
