

# King and Cross | How to Help People Follow Jesus

**Group Notes** 

#### INTRODUCTION

Jesus assembled His first group of disciples around a very specific mission – to become "fishers of people" (Mark 1:16-20). Not "follow me and I will make you theologians, Christian counselors, small groups leaders etc.", but rather, leave your nets, leave your occupation, leave your friends, leave even your family, and come follow Me. The demands are great, but Jesus is a great King and the blessings of knowing Him are far greater! Jesus calls His followers to be fishers of people. That is accomplished not with bait, hooks, or nets, but with a powerful, sometimes confrontational, and compelling message! It is the message we must proclaim today.

### **GROUP DISCUSSION**

- 1. Who has God put in your life that would benefit from a relationship with Jesus?

- 3. Why do you think Jesus chose fishermen to be His disciples instead of more educated alternatives? What can we learn from this about what God wants in a disciple?
- 4. Does the assignment to "fish for people" involve grace or judgment? Explain.
- 5. What possible reasons/excuses might someone have for not answering His call to "follow me"?
- 6. If you have responded to Jesus' call to "Follow Me", how has your life been affected or changed?



#### **PRAYER**

Go around your group and share about someone you would like to see say "yes" to Jesus and place their faith and trust in Him. As a group, spend time praying over each other. Ask God to give you courage to step out this week and share how Jesus has changed your life.
