



Preteen Camp 2025 Details

Session One Dates: May 26 - May 28

Session Two Dates: May 30 - June 1

Details for both sessions will be the same. Any specifics that may arise will be communicated via email, so ***please mark our emails as important.***

CHECK-IN:

Check-in locations will be decided based on the volume of registrations. We will email you with check in instructions as camp gets closer.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

There will be a medical station for you to check in all medicines on check in day. Please bring prescriptions in the bottle with instructions. Any over the counter medications, vitamins or supplements should be packed in a plastic bag with only the dosage needed for the week. We will have nurses from Sun Valley at camp to administer all medications to preteens. Preteens will not be able to administer medications to themselves unless they have received previous authorization.

ROOMING

Boys and girls will stay in separate dorm-style rooms with two adult leaders per room. Preteens will have their own twin bed and must bring their own bedding.

MEALS & DIETARY RESTRICTIONS

The camp will provide all meals. The meals are all-you-can-eat buffet-style. UCYC can accommodate those with Gluten allergies ONLY. For more specific dietary needs, there will be fridge space available at camp if you need to pack your own food.

FORMS

You have received a link to a waiver in your email. Please fill out the waiver before check in.

INSURANCE / DAMAGES

Sun Valley is financially responsible for damages to the UCYC properties. Any charges to Sun Valley due to damages by preteens will be passed on to the families of the preteens who caused the damages.

CAMP RULES

- Respect yourself and others.
- No guys in girls' dorms and no girls in guys' dorms.
- Alcohol, tobacco, drugs, and weapons are prohibited.
- You must be in your dorm by the designated "Lights Out" on the schedule.
- Respect the camp - no TP, water balloons, shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, etc. No practical jokes!
- Do not move furniture - you will be assessed a damage fee.
- Absolutely no fireworks at any time during camp.
- No food deliveries of any kind to the camp.
- Preteens may leave camp ONLY with adult supervision.
- Follow the camp dress code as seen in the "What to Bring" lists.
- Accessing inappropriate content on personal devices will result in a phone call to parents. Please remind your kids what is and what isn't appropriate.
- If these rules are not followed, or if an incident of magnitude arises, your student will be sent home at the parent's expense.

PACKING LIST

WHAT TO BRING

- Bible & pen
- Casual clothing for three days and some sneakers
- Team Color Spirit Gear (clothes/bandanas/face paint/tutus etc!)
- Towels, washcloth/loofah, and personal hygiene items
- Bedding & Pillow (ie. twin sized sheets and a sleeping bag or blanket)
- Spending money for camp gear, snacks, etc. (\$20-50 recommended)
- Sunscreen
- Refillable water bottle
- Appropriate swimwear for pool time (one piece or tankini)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Tobacco (or electronic cigarettes/vapes), Drugs, Alcohol, Fireworks, Weapons
- Water Balloons/Sidewalk chalk/practical joke items
- Inappropriate clothing/swimwear: tube tops, halter tops, bikinis, speedos, very short shorts or anything with inappropriate language or images
- Camp is best experienced distraction-free, so we suggest you *do not send your child with a phone*. Sun Valley is not responsible or liable for lost, stolen, or broken cell phones and they may be confiscated by preteen directors in the case of misuse.
