

# The Priority Paradox | Week 2

## Introduction

#### Group Discussion (45 minutes)

- 1. Where in your life have you aligned your priorities with God's, and where have you missed the mark?
- 2. What is the most difficult thing for you when it comes to priorities?
- 3. Why do you think it matters to God that our priorities are aligned with Him? Read aloud: <u>Matthew 11:28-30</u>, <u>Matthew 6:33</u>, <u>Luke 12:34</u>, <u>I Timothy 3:5</u>
- 4. Share moments in your life when your priorities were not aligned as they should have been. How did that affect your life?
- 5. What do you believe your top three priorities should be?
- 6. Often, we give our leftover time to the most important things What is one thing you can do this week to reverse that trend?

#### Prayer (5 minutes)

Close your group in prayer. Thank God that He cares so much for each of us that He wants us to prioritize Him in our lives.
