Introduction

Group Discussion (45 minutes)

1. In what way is God inviting you to participate in His story?
2. What has motivated you to get involved in the mission of not just coming to church, but of being The Church? What tends to hold you back?
3. Is there an area of your life where you know you have been apathetic, disobedient, or lazy in living out God's calling on your life?
 - a. If you just confessed something—way to go! It takes courage to be vulnerable. Take some time to pause and pray for one another in the areas where we have confessed we have missed the mark. Thank God for revealing it to you and for his forgiveness. Ask for His help to guide you to what is next. Pray for courage. Ask your group members to help hold you accountable.
4. Read [Acts 1:8](#).
 - a. What does being a "witness" look like in your everyday life?
 - b. How does this verse connect to Chad's statement about greatness being thrust upon us through the Holy Spirit?
 - c. In what ways are you living out and activating that greatness in your life?
5. One of the most powerful ways we can be a "witness" to others is to share our personal stories of what Jesus has done in our lives.
 - a. Share with the group a story of the work Jesus has done in your life.
 - b. Who else in your life could benefit from hearing your story?

6. Is there a step, big or small, you sense God prompting you to take into a greater impact in His story?
