 - a. What stands out to you about how the people in the early church lived?
 - b. How does this challenge or affirm your understanding of community?
 - c. What might the principles of this passage look like today at Sun Valley Community Church?
4. How can our small group create a culture of sacrificial generosity that extends beyond our circle to impact our community?
5. What is one specific way you can practice sacrificial generosity this week - giving your time, talents, or resources in a way that might be uncomfortable but meaningful?
6. Throughout this series, we have discussed the statement, "*The church is not a building you come and sit in, but a movement you choose to be a part of to help people meet, know, and follow Jesus.*"
 - a. Have you joined the movement? If yes, in what way(s)? If not, what is holding you back?
 - b. Take some time to pray for one another in these areas specifically. Pray for boldness, faith, and courage in trusting God with what is next. Pray for God to work in and through you as you take a step of obedience. Pray for the impact it will have.
